Registration Process

1. Complete and return the registration form and \$75 for each course to the Iowa Ministry Network before attending class.
2. Additional registration fee of \$50, if the spouse also desires to take classes. Shipping is included in the fee.
3. Class audit fee of \$50 – no credit will be given toward a credential and no transcript will be kept.

Registration Deadline: three (3) weeks prior to class date.

Late Fee: An additional \$15 will be charged for those registrations postmarked or received less than three (3) weeks prior to the scheduled ISOM class. If a husband and wife are both late, both will be charged the additional \$15. No registration postmarked less than two (2) weeks prior to class will be allowed.

Withdrawal Policy: Written notification of withdrawal from a class must be postmarked or received in the IMN office three (3) weeks prior to the first day of the scheduled ISOM class in order to receive a \$35 refund.

Emergencies: The ISOM leadership reserves the right to determine exceptions to the above policies in medical and emergency situations.
